

## **MALARIA AND ANTIMALARIAL SENSITIVITY PROFILES IN BOUGAINVILLE (PAUPUA NEW GUINEA)**

After a decade of civil war on Bougainville and the complete destruction of its health infrastructure, endemic malaria remains one of the most serious health concerns facing this island province of PNG. Febrile Patients from 3 health clinics were tested for malaria infection. The sensitivity of 35 fresh *Plasmodium falciparum* isolates were screened against 10 antimalarials (including the antifolate WR99210) in the field using the standard WHO microtest.
